Upcoming Events - Upcoming events are discussed by all members and motions are made and voted upon.

General Business - An opportunity to bring anything P&C related to the attention of all present for discussion.

All memberships lapse. Memberships only last until the next AGM, including executive roles.

Join (or re-join!) - the AGM is the only meeting where memberships can be accepted immediately (and members don't need to be present to join at the AGM).


Executive Nomination - Members can nominate and be nominated for executive positions
