This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students in Prep to Year 2 achieving the anticipated reading benchmark from 80% to 85%
- Increase the percentage of students in Prep to Year 2 achieving an A-C for English to 80%
- Undertake early intervention with Prep students
- Focus on consistency of practice in our guided reading
- Build inclusive practices across the school with regard to student engagement

Our initiatives include

- Embed data review practices within each term
- Implementing oral language and phonological awareness programs in Prep
- Creating mentoring, coaching and collegial observation opportunities for teachers to refine practice
- Collaborating to develop an early years methodology for pedagogy within literacy blocks
- Training teacher aides in the teaching of reading using departmental modules
- Building a bank of quality assured literacy resources to support the teaching of reading, literacy blocks, and English
- Identifying inclusive practices that increase student attendance and engagement

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employ experienced teacher to lead our reading initiatives - \$120 000
- Employ teacher aides to implement the oral language and phonological awareness programs in Prep - \$17 000
- Provide opportunities for teachers to meet in teams to analyse student learning data - \$11 000
- Purchase additional resources to support the implementation of reading assessments - \$8632
- Employ experienced teacher for Term 1 as Student Engagement Officer - \$25 000
